When Citing a Reprint Within Another Source

Give the information for the ORIGINAL SOURCE first:

- **Author** Last name, First name.
- **Title** of original source being cited in “quotation marks.”
- **Title of source in which the article was originally published** in *italics*.
- **Volume, issue, year** of publication (if available). The format will vary here depending on what type of source you are citing (ex. Journal, magazine, newspaper, etc.).
- **Page numbers.**
- According to the *MLA Handbook* (158) you do not need to record the medium of the previous publication.

Give the information for the REPRINT next:

- **“Rpt. in”** is used to indicate the fact that your original source was reprinted.
- **Title of the publication** in *italics*.
- **Authors** (By), **editors** (Ed.), or **compilers** (Comp.) and following the abbreviation list names by First name, Last name.
- **City:** Publisher, Year.
- **Page numbers.**
- **Medium of publication** (print, web, etc.).

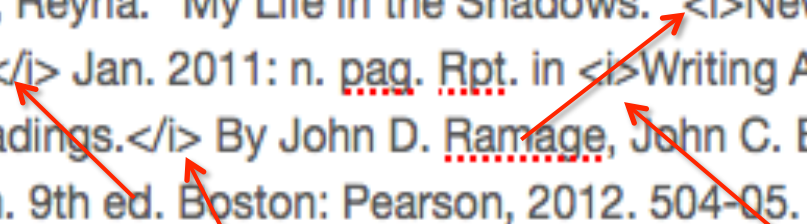
