


## Developmental Education Definition

Developmental education refers to the range of courses and activities designed to prepare students to complete credit bearing college courses successfully.


## FTIC Students in 2-Year and 4-Year Institutions by College Readiness Status Fall 2003




## 2-Year FTIC Students by College Readiness Status and Ethnicity Fall 2003




## 4-Year FTIC Students by College Readiness Status and Ethnicity Fall 2003




## 2-Year FTIC Students by College Readiness Status and Age Fall 2003




#### Percentage of 2005 High School Graduates who Enter Higher Education College-Ready by High School Curriculum




# Percentage of FTIC Developmental Education Students Completing the First College-Level Course Fall 2003




# Percentage of FTIC Developmental Education Students Who Achieved College Readiness Fall 2003




# Percentage of FTIC DE Students who completed DE, Attempted and Successfully Completed the First College-Level Course Fall 2003

# Developmental Education Funding Methodology

■ DE funding is provided only for courses - the same level of funding in the formula as that for credit-bearing courses.

Non-course based DE is not funded.

# Funds Appropriated for Developmental Education

- \$206 million appropriated in formula during 2006-07 biennium
- \$227 million appropriated in formula during 2008-09 biennium
- ~\$224 million in current 2010-2011 formula recommendation

### Recommendation

Create a developmental education strategy that focuses on addressing the academic and social needs of first-time college students who are not college ready.

## The strategy includes...

- Strong and committed administrative and professional staff support
- Comprehensive diagnostic and assessment instruments
- Counseling that focuses on academic/social/cultural needs of students
- Innovative program approaches
- Time on task
- Evaluative approach that recognizes program and student milestones

## A new approach to college readiness

- Level 1: Refresher level
- Level 2: Short/mid-term interventions
- Level 3: Long-term interventions
- Level 4: Basic skills (ABE)

## **Funding Innovation**

This strategy requires new funding mechanisms that reward innovation:

New strategy includes \$40 million directly appropriated to the Coordinating Board for funding innovative DE activities.
